Recognition and Management of the Seriously III Patient (RAMSI)



When a crisis occurs, working within a team is critical so therefore training together makes sense, the RAMSI course enables nurses and allied health professionals to train together, developing skills required to recognise and care for acutely ill patients.

Using simulation-based education, the course focuses on a systematic approach to caring for seriously ill patients with an emphasis on team dynamics, communication skills, leadership and situational awareness. The course runs over a full day at the Montagu Clinical Simulation Centre at Mexborough.
